


RGM Govt. College JoginderNagar

Action Taken Report (2015-2016)

1. Vacant posts in the departments of English, Sanskrit, and History were filled up out of PTA fund.
2. Posts of data entry operator, lab attendant and sweeper were also filled up out of PTA fund.
3. PTA subscription fee was increased from Rs. 200 to Rs. 300 yearly.
4. Feedback from students, parents and alumni regarding teaching work, infrastructure available and co-curricular activities was taken.
5. As per the demand of CSCA and recommendation of IQAC a drinking water tank was installed in the college premises.
6. A talent hunt competition to trap the talent of students and prepare them for Youth festivals was organized on 23rd August 2015.
7. CSCA organized a cleanliness campaign in 24th August 2015.
8. Women cell sensitized the students about personal hygiene and proper sanitization.
9. Library committee pertaining to e-learning resources and magazines were reconstituted.
10. A separate room was allotted to the department of Music (Vocal).
11. Assignments of students were evaluated, seminars were organized and awards for CCA were entered in the website of HPU Shimla before the commencement of semester exams.
12. CSCA cultural function "Aakarshan" was held on 28th December 2015.
13. Educational tour was organized in February, 2016 to Great Himalayan National Park Sai Ropa park, Banjar.
14. H.P. University X-country championship was hosted on 1st September 2015.
15. Additional learning material to academically brilliant students was provided by teachers of different faculties.

16. For the promotion of virtual teaching, Room No. 102 & 201 was converted into smart classrooms.
17. Equipments of Rs. 2,31,511/- were purchased for Physics and Chemistry labs.
18. Uniforms of rovers and rangers amounting to Rs. 10460/- were purchased.
19. For the safety of office files and records, racks of Rs. 12,150/- were purchased.
20. 10 desktops amounting to Rs. 4,070,43/-, multimedia projector of Rs. 44,940/- and digital podium of Rs. 1,58,999/-, interactive pad of Rs. 6668/-, Virtual presenter of Rs. 35,175/- and 60 chairs for smart classrooms of Rs. 1,71,000/- and 38 curtain blind vertical for smart classrooms of Rs. 30,360/- were purchased.
21. An amount of Rs. 10,000/- was utilized for construction work of new stage.
22. Articles of sports amounting to Rs. 1,32,053/- were purchased.
23. Computer tables of Rs. 1,91,100/- were also purchased.
24. UPS Numeric 1000VA, Wi-Fi in campus, wi-fi router, pH meter, compound microscopes and microprocessor amounting Rs. 1,31,841/- were purchased.
25. An amount of Rs. 9,75,000/- was utilized for display counter, installation of electrical transformer and water purifier.
26. 355 new books pertaining to different subjects of Rs. 1,65,690/- were purchased for library.
27. Senior most teachers took classes of teachers who proceeded to attend orientation programmes, refresher courses, seminars, conferences and short term courses.
28. Construction work of new building, including multipurpose hall, expansion of college canteen and accommodation for staff was started during the session.
29. Important days were celebrated and co-curricular activities were organized.
30. Members of teaching faculty attended orientation programmes, refresher courses and induction training programmes.
