## About the College :

With the towering mountain range as the back drop Rajiv Gandhi Memorial Govt. College Joginder Nagar came into being in May 1994 is an institution of higher learning at Joginder Nagar, a sub division of Mandi district in Himachal Pradesh. Surrounded by the green foliage of several hues and the terraced field, ideal pollution free atmosphere. The important highlight of the college is that girl students out number the boys. The total strength of the college in this session is 2523 out of which 1124 are boys and 1399 are girls.

## About NSS Unit -

As per the strength of this college, there are two NSS unit. Each unit is controlled by one NSS Program Officer and there is an enrollment of approximately 317 volunteers. Out of the total strength of 317, 142 are male and 175 are female volunteers. The process of enrollment was initiated in June 2017 and completed by July 2017. 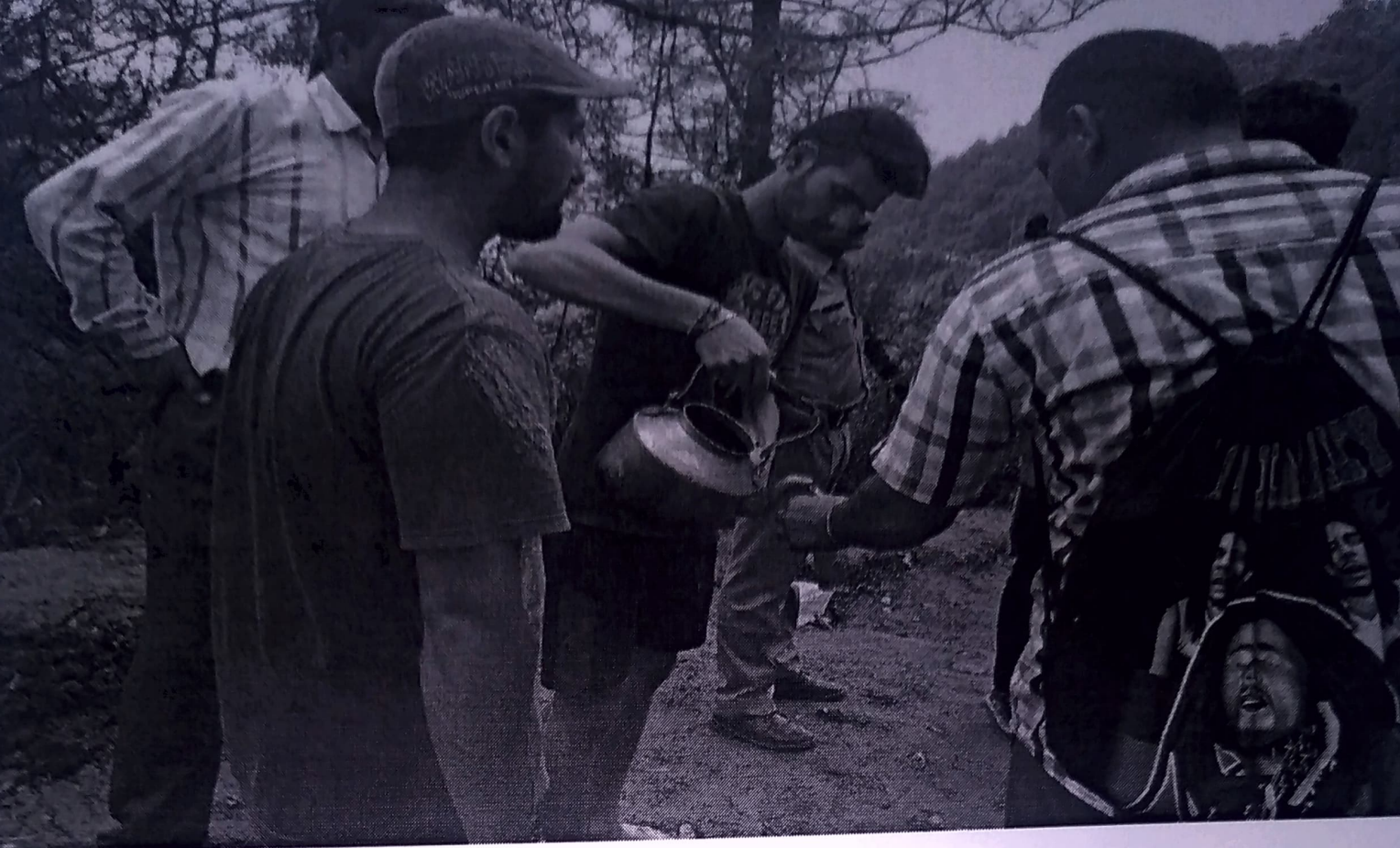


















(vi) **State Level NSS Mega Camp for colleges & universities - 2017** :- On 26<sup>th</sup> September 2017, State level NSS Mega Camp for colleges and Universities was held at General Zorawar Singh College Dhaneta, Distt. Hamirpur (HP). 04 NSS volunteers 02 Boys & 02 Girls participated in this camp from 26<sup>th</sup> September to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

(vii) **Training Programme under HPSDMA-UNDP project 2017** :- From 24<sup>th</sup> September to 26<sup>th</sup> September 2017 Under Project " Implementation of Training & Capacity Building calendar under HPSDMA-UNDP project 2017" 03 days training programme was organized at Herbal Garden Joginder Nagar. NSS volunteers are given training regarding early warning of disaster, search and rescue first aid, water sanitation and hygiene etc.

**Special Camp:-** The special camp was organized for seven days w.e.f. 16<sup>th</sup> December 2017 to 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2017. 89 volunteers including 29 boys and 60 girls participated in this residential camp. Efforts were made to educate the volunteers by various activities in the camp. The emphasis was given to discipline, cooperation and dignity of labor.

**16<sup>th</sup> December 2017 :-** All the volunteers are divided in 06 groups, duties for next 06 days are divided within these groups as on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2018 group 2<sup>nd</sup> conduct assembly, Group 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> take responsibility of cleanliness, Group 6<sup>th</sup> look after sports and evening activities and group 1<sup>st</sup> make breakfast, lunch & dinner.







In these 03 days lunch was prepared at "Balakrupi" temple. Volunteers interacts with villagers and ward members they were informed about the role of cleanliness in daily life and informed to take majors <sup>steps</sup> to lead healthy disease free life.

In evening Panchayt pradhan Sh. Sansar Chand addresses the volunteers and give valuable information about Panchayat and role of villages in economic development.

On 19<sup>th</sup> September 2017 evening Dr. Jitender Chauhan, SMO Civil Hospital Joginder Nagar, delivered a lecture on Disaster Management, disease spread through different animals and how to cure them.





Valedictory function was held at 02:00pm in college seminar room. Sh. Sansar Chand, Panchayat Pradhan Balakrupi lower grodu was the chief guest with ward members & villagers.
