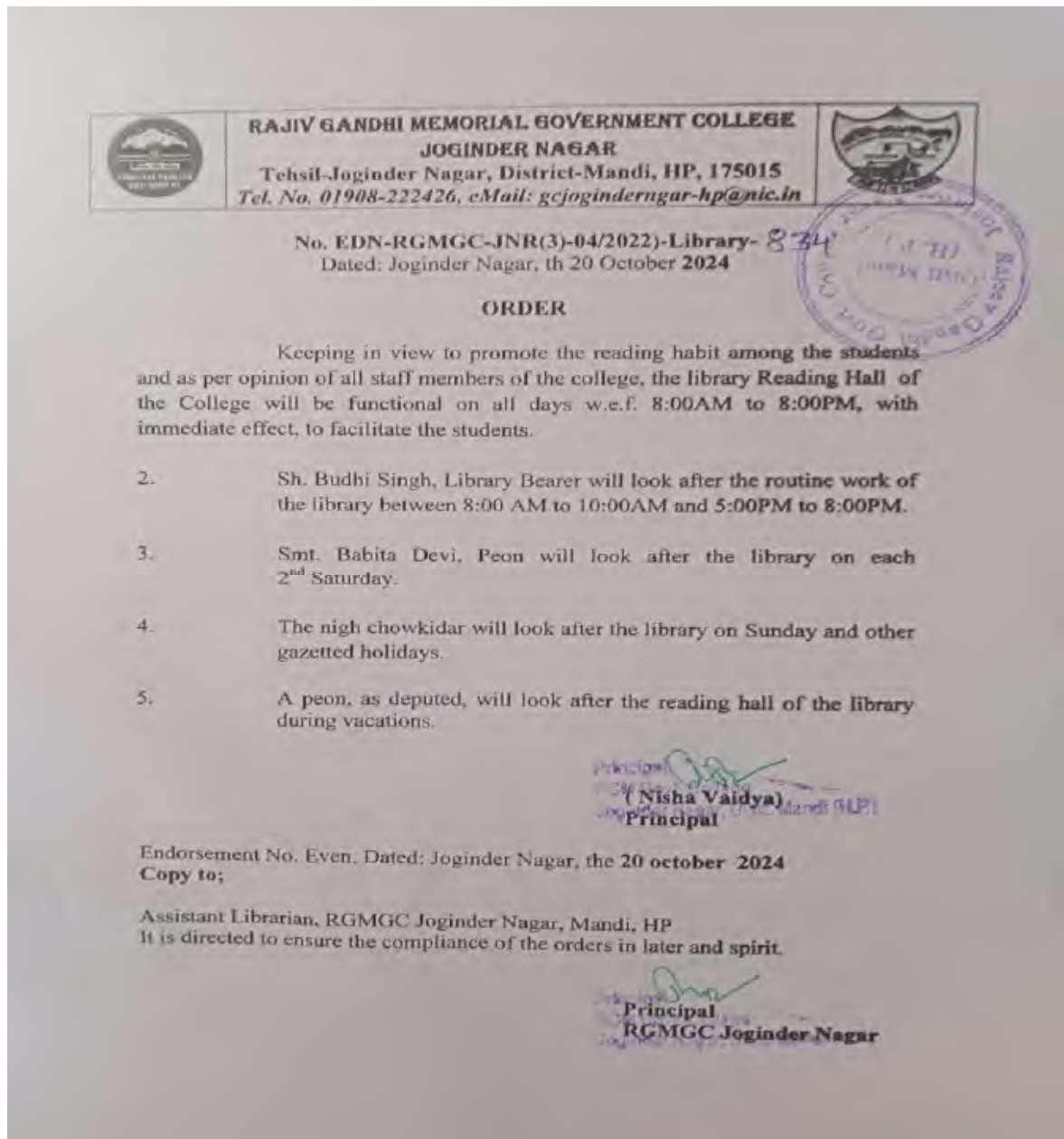

### **Library facility is extended to old students.**

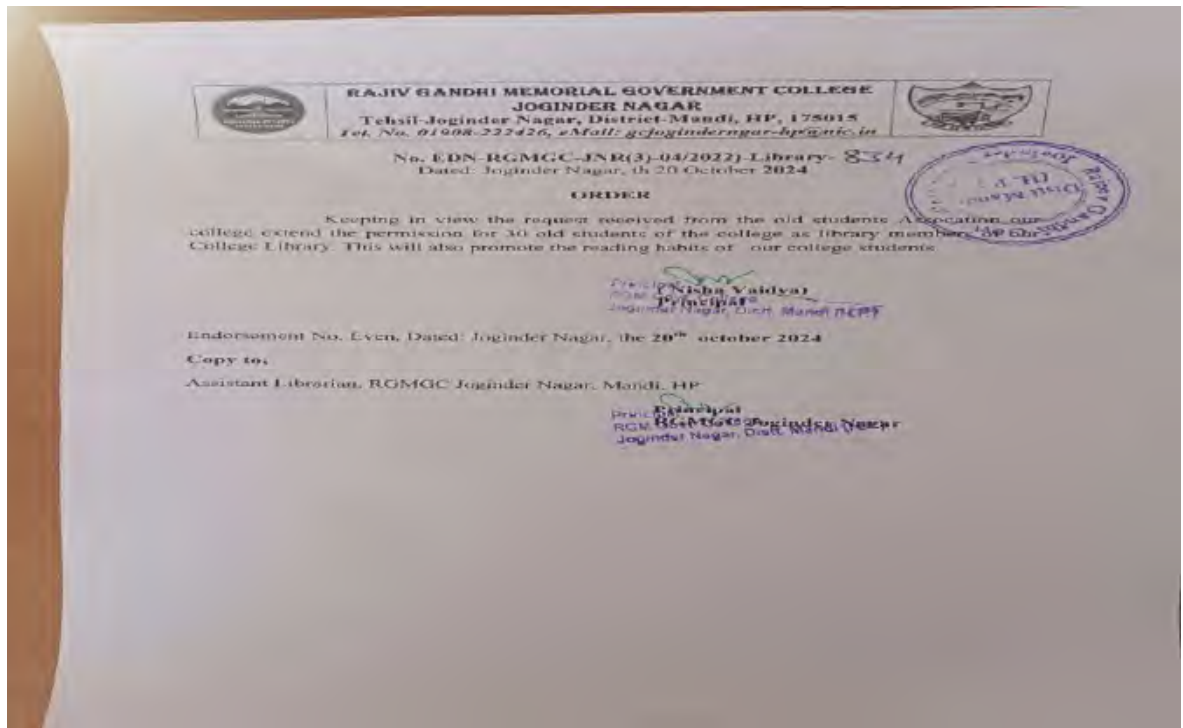

Mohinder Lal and Shivam Rana, are the old students of our college and members of library. Both of them have qualified JOA IT Exam in 2024.

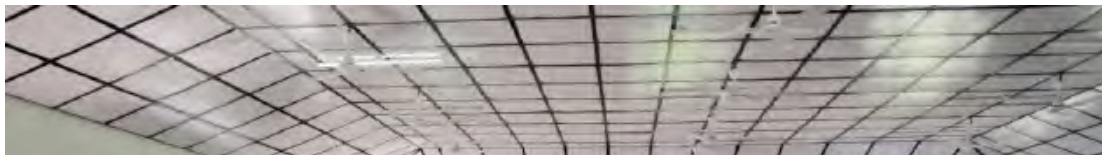


### **New Library reading room with a seating capacity for one hundred students.**







